**P**rovisional License drivers can drive between **5:00 AM to Midnight**.

Driving time may be extended for work or religious reasons if the employer or religious authority provides written verification.

- **You** may have passengers from your shared residence plus one additional person in your vehicle.
- **You cannot** use any interactive wireless communication (cell phones) at anytime except for an emergency. “Use” includes talking or listening to any interactive wireless communication device, operating its keys, buttons or other controls.
- **You** are responsible to ensure that all occupants of the vehicle are secured in a properly adjusted and fastened seatbelt or child restraint system.

If the provisional license holder is 21 or older, passenger and hour restrictions do not apply.

## Driving Under the Influence and the Provisional Driver's License

Upon a conviction for a blood alcohol reading between .01% to .08% :

- License suspension from 30 to 90 days.
- Numerous fines.
- Perform community service for a period of 15 to 30 days.
- Court ordered attendance at an Intoxicated Driver Resource Program.
- Attendance at a Motor Vehicle Commission remedial training course of 4 hours or more.

These penalties are in addition to other penalties that can be imposed for a violation of any other D.U.I. laws.

If you are convicted of any alcohol or drug related offense unrelated to the operation of a motor vehicle, the director of The Motor Vehicle Commission, when notified by the court, shall revoke your license for six months.

## Can you afford it?

A ticket for speeding will result in the following...

- 1-9 MPH over - \$85.00, 2 points
- 10 - 14 MPH over - \$95.00, 2 points
- 15 - 19 MPH over - \$105.00, 4 points  
+ insurance surcharges
- 20 + MPH over - \$200.00 , 4 points  
+ insurance surcharges

**Bridgewater Municipal Court Judge may revoke your driver's license for 30 days or more for speeds over 20 MPH.**

Director of N.J. Motor Vehicle Commission can impose additional sanctions.
