Speed is Lethal !

If you hit a pedestrian-

- At 20 MPH, 5% will die
- At 30 MPH, 45% will die
- At 40 MPH, 85% will die
- At 50 MPH, almost all will die

You need time and space to stop

- At 20 MPH it takes you 47 feet to stop your car.
- At 30 MPH, the distance almost doubles (88 feet)
- At 40 MPH, it takes 149 feet to stop your vehicle.

Studies have shown that most motorists stopped for speeding live within a one mile radius of the road that they're stopped on.

The Traffic Safety Unit is taking a proactive approach to identify high volume roads that have speeding issues. We use the three E's for this approach.

Evaluate - We utilize several tools to obtain traffic volume and speed data on roadways.

Educate - We use our speed trailer and speed signs to display vehicle speeds to warn motorists.

Enforcement - We then come back to enforce the speed limits.
